FREIGHT TARIFF IHB 6010-C

PRIVATE RATE FUEL SURCHARGE TARIFF

In the event that the average price of West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil (WTI), calculated monthly based on prices published in the Wall Street Journal, equals or exceeds \$28.00 per barrel, IHB will have the right to apply a fuel surcharge to the freight charge(s) referencing or subject to this authority. If this right is exercised, the fuel surcharge shall be applied to the freight charges for each shipment having a Bill of Lading or Interchange date on or after the 1st day of the second calendar month following the calendar month of a given WTI Average Price calculation.

The fuel surcharge will be 1% of the applicable freight charges for every \$2.50 per barrel, or portion thereof by which the WTI Average Price exceeds \$28.00 per barrel. The WTI Average Price will be determined by adding the daily West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil prices published in the Wall Street Journal during a particular calendar month by the number of days so published in that calendar month. The result will be rounded to the nearest cent. If the Wall Street Journal ceases publication of the price of West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil, the IHB will employ a suitable substitute.

This surcharge will not apply to tariffs IHB-3001 series, IHB-8000 series, IHB 8300 series, IHB 8325 series IHB 8530 series, and IHB 9347 series.
